


Fig 3: Trends in % women reporting first birth <16 years by age cohort from first DHS survey: Sub Saharan African Countries.




Fig 4: Trends in % women reporting first birth before aged 16 years by birth cohort for three consecutive DHS: Uganda




Fig 5. Trends in % women reporting first birth before aged 16 years by birth cohort for three consecutive DHS: Mali


